NOTIFICATION PLAN

Our water system is small (Two Churches and school). Upon discovery of an emergency a flyer detailing the action items needed for the owner/staff to follow is created. A phone call and email are emailed/provided to the owner and staff outlining instructions in English and Spanish to follow:

1. Post the emergency flyer at each location entrance, each building and notification boards. If the emergency dictates the restrooms and kitchen would be locked by the owner/staff.
2. Staff will go room to room notifying teachers and providing copies of flyers for each student. Notifications will be completed for parents and students via phone calls / text message / flyers.
3. The flyer will include details on action plan for the water at the site, up to and including turning off all water usage facilities at the locations.
4. It is estimated that the entire service area can be covered in less than two hours.
5. Photos are to be sent to KJ Water Systems as proof of the posted notification flyers to confirm notification instructions were followed.
6. KJ Water Services will notify the owner and staff once the emergency is concluded and normal use of the water can resume.
